**Intentions for 2021-2022: Learning Options.** All parents and guardians are asked to make their intentions known by **Mar 22, 2021** as to which option (online or in-person) they will be choosing for the 2021-2022 school year. This must be done on Powerschool for each child. If you need help, please call the school for assistance 780-489-1981. Reminder that there is only one entry point for online learning (upon registration) with only one opportunity to return to in-person learning (Feb 1, 2022). Online learning is available for K-12, but online French Immersion will only be offered for gr 4-9.

**Scrub-a-Dub Donations.** Toiletries for those in need are still being collected for the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. Students can bring donations of toiletries such as shampoo, conditioner, soap (both liquid and bar), toothbrushes, and toothpaste to their classrooms.
