We hope everyone had a safe and happy Halloween and we wish you all the best for this second quarter. Our Trustee, Terry Harris, joined us at our recent meeting on Nov 4. Here are some highlights from that meeting for your information.

**ECSD Update.** The Board continues to lobby the provincial government for adequate additional funding and resources to support all facets of student learning that have been impacted by the pandemic, including enhancements for online learning programs. \$15.6 million received in Federal Government funding will be used to partially offset a variety of COVID-related costs. Expenses are over \$20M and ECSD will use its reserves to cover the full cost. ECSD is also connecting with all metro boards to coordinate communications with the Minister of Education and join forces.

Hamper Program. Families that received a Thanksgiving Hamper were very appreciative and we would like to thank Kathryn Lennon and Geraldine Simpson for delivering the hampers and thank the Holy Cross community for their support of this program. It is because of the generosity at Holy Cross that we are able to continue with this program at our school. Thank you!
